The Birdsboro Municipal Authority (the “Authority”) watershed is the approximately 1,800 acre parcel real estate consisting of, among other things, forest lands, trails, climbing venues and reservoirs (the Watershed”).

The following rules and regulations shall apply to the use of the Watershed:

1. The Watershed shall be **open to the public between dawn and dusk.**
2. Pets are permitted if they are kept under control and attended.
3. There are no trash receptacles provided at the Watershed. Trash must be removed, and littering and disposing of garbage or any other waste is prohibited.
4. No camping or campfires are permitted.
5. Swimming in any of the reservoirs in the Watershed is prohibited, including pets.
6. Trespassing from the Watershed on to the neighboring quarry land is prohibited.
7. Possession of illegal drugs or narcotics is prohibited. Consumption of alcohol by anyone regardless of age is prohibited.
8. No motorized off-road vehicles, all-terrain vehicles and snowmobiles (“Off-Road Vehicles”) may be operated unless authorized.
9. Bicycles may be operated on designated open roads or trails, and must be operated in a safe manner, with careful regard for the welfare of other persons and property.
10. Horseback riding may occur on designated open roads or trails, and must be operated in a safe manner, with careful regard for the welfare of other persons and property.
11. Rock climbing is permitted at the risk of the participant, and should be performed with careful regard for safety.
12. The use or discharge of any type of firearm, air gun, sling shot, bow or explosive device is prohibited, unless permission has been given by permit.
13. Law enforcement personnel’s use of the pistol range at the Watershed shall take priority over any other activity taking place at the Watershed, and visitors may be asked to leave the Watershed in the event that law enforcement personnel is utilizing the same.
14. Damaging, defacing or removing any sign, structure, or other equipment or material is prohibited.
15. The Watershed is under video surveillance. Anyone who violates these rules and regulations may be ordered to leave the Watershed, or face civil or criminal penalties.
